THE FYI PROGRAM The First Year Introduction to Art Foundation Program

The FYI Program serves as a one-year preparatory program to the Art Foundation/BFA program. FYI develops students' artistic talents through two semesters of studio coursework, and supports the development of creative fluency through concurrent courses covering topics including digital art tools, leadership, and design language. As a precursor to the Art Foundation program, FYI focuses on composition, visual perception, two- and three-dimensional design work, design principles, and more. Successful completion of the FYI program qualifies students for entry into the Art Foundation program, and prepares them to perform with a competitive edge in studio courses. Following the completion of the Art Foundation program, students then enter the BFA program with the selection of an area of specialization - Interior Design, Graphic Design, Fashion Design, and Painting and Printmaking. Students generally complete the FYI/Art Foundation/BFA in 5 years.

The FYI Program is designed for incoming freshmen who demonstrate academic promise, but show a need for additional studio preparation prior to their entrance into the Art Foundation program. FYI's purpose is to accelerate the development of creativity, technical skill, professional awareness, and confidence. Indeed, past graduates of the FYI program have proven to be amongst the most talented and well-prepared VCU students.
